Can I find employment? Faith Community Nurses are employed by hospitals as FCN Coordinators throughout the country, networking and coordinating education for local faith community nursing groups and assisting chaplain services to provide spiritual care and support during acute care stays.

How will I serve my community? Faith Community Nursing services vary based on need and setting. Advocacy, health promotion, education, blood pressure clinics, chronic disease management, and spiritual care are just a few ways a Faith Community Nurse can serve a community.
